COVID - 19 Impact - Kharikhola

The prolonged COVID-19 crisis has created unprecedented challenges in the social and economic sectors throughout Nepal. Like many other remote communities of Nepal, Kharikhola ward no: 1 of Khumbu Pasanglhmau Rural Municipality has been badly hit by the impact of Covid.

More than (90% people of (ward no 1) Kharikhola are dependent on tourism.

In response to cases worldwide increasing exponentially and amid growing public concern, the government of Nepal suspended the 'Visit Nepal 2020' and locked the country down and suspended all national and international flights. The collapse of international and domestic tourism in the Everest region resulted in widespread unemployment, loss of income and threatened livelihoods for many families in Kharikhola and Khumbu region.

The most affected families in ward no 1, Kharikhola were the one working as porters and daily wage labourers. To support these families Rotary Club of Kathmandu Mid-Town, Lisa 's family and Action for Nepal came together with the food relief program, so these economically backward families could have some relief from having access to food supplies.
